- Providing medical care to children



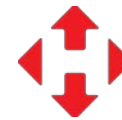
Since 2014, upon the Russian invasion in the territory of independent Ukraine, the following purposes were added:

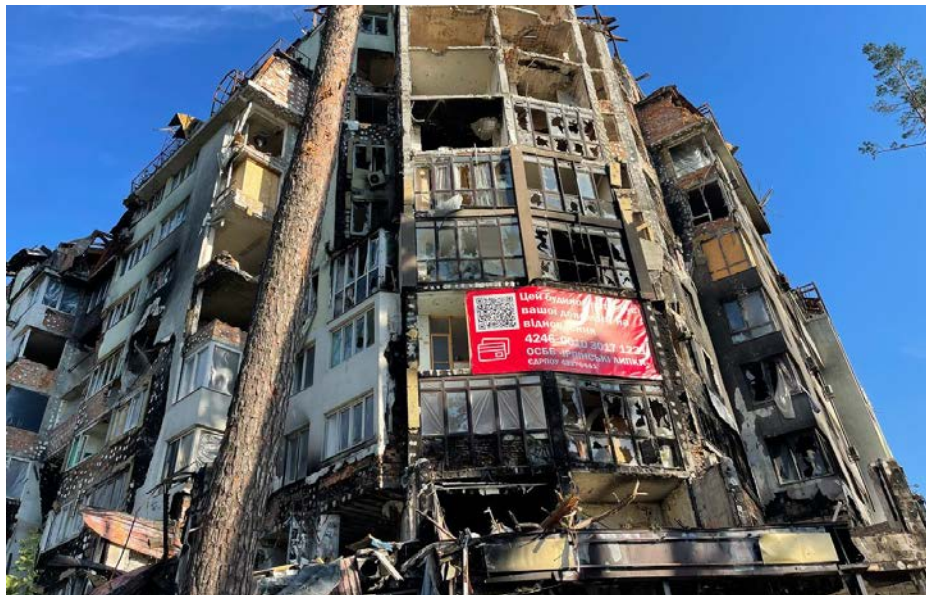


- Recovering social infrastructure facilities (schools, kindergartens, cultural centres, etc.) affected by Russian hostilities against Ukraine
- Developing new residential housing stock in Ukraine in substitution of destroyed one and recovering the undamaged
- Providing assistance to Ukraine's civilians, who have fully or partially lost their housing
- Aiding refugee families and orphans
- Arranging repair of cars for the ATO, helping to provide fuel and lubricants to them

The escalation of the conflict between Ukraine and Russia along with the virtually full-scale warfare broken out throughout the whole territory of Ukraine in February 2022 led to a catastrophic increase of death toll among civilians, damage of residential housing and social infrastructure facilities.

All this entailed a sweeping humanitarian crisis in Ukraine, countless number of requests for help from local communities, hospitals, educational establishments and civilians.

It made the Foundation seek new partners and implement new projects.



Charitable Foundation «PEACE AND GOOD»

has taken up the organisation of providing humanitarian assistance to those affected by the Russian hostilities. We have established offices for providing emergency help in Kyiv and the regions of Kyiv, Kharkiv, Sumy, Zaporizhzhia, Mykolaiv, Donetsk and Kherson. We have also created special mobile teams for delivering aid to affected towns next to the frontline.

Our volunteers provide targeted assistance to temporary displaced persons, families that have lost their housing for good, as well as orphanages left unsupported:
